

Ranking Points Distribution

Players participating on the WFGA Tour can win points for the WFGA World Rankings. The points won are valid for the rankings in accordance with the following rules:

- Points are valid for two years. After one year points are halved and after two years they are deleted. Deletion and halving of points happen after the first tournament in the season is played and finished.
 (Working progress) For the future we are trying to create a system where the points from every individual tournament have an exact lifetime of two years and will be recounted individually from other tournaments.
- As no competition took place in 2020, the points won in 2018 and 2019 will be considered to define the ranking at the beginning of season 2021. Points from season 2019 will expire in season 2022.
- The player's 5 best tournament scores in 2021 are counted for the ranking.
- If there are 3 or less participants for a category, the category is cancelled, and no ranking points will be given.
- If a Juniors category is cancelled in tournament, the remaining Juniors are allowed to participate in the Men/Women category and earn ranking points for this category.
- A +55 player is also part of the Men/Women Singles category and therefore able to reach two podiums and earn points for two different rankings.
- A player is accepted as a +55 player the year he/she turns 55 years old.



Tournaments are weighted as following:

(Doubles are counted by the number of players and NOT by the number of teams. In Doubles both players get the number of points won)

Points for Men's Single/Double:

Open Championship

50 Points to win. Per 25 players over 50 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

Matchplay Championship

75 Points to win. Per 25 players over 75 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

World Championship

150 Points to win. Per 25 players over 150 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

Points for Women's Single/Double & Men +55:

Open Championship

50 Points to win. Per 5 players over 10 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

Matchplay Championship

75 Points to win. Per 5 players over 15 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

World Championship

150 Points to win. Per 5 players over 30 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

Points for Women +55 & Juniors:

Open Championship

50 Points to win. Per 5 players over 5 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

Matchplay Championship

75 Points to win. Per 5 players over 10 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.

World Championship

150 Points to win. Per 5 players over 25 players in the category, the points will increase with 25 points.



Calculation Systems

Men's Single/Double

The winner gets 100% of the points available. To award a top 3 performance, there will be a fixed difference of 8 percent of the maximum points dividing the positions 1-4.

The rest of the positions will have a decay factor of 0,96.

* Example:

A player participating in the World Championship in the men's category with 160 participants and finishing 38th will get:

• 18,97 % of 150 points = 28,45 points

If the competition had 201 players, the same player finishing 38th would get:

• 18,97 % of 200 points = 37,94 points



Women's Single/Double, Juniors & +55 Categories

The winner gets 100% of the points available. To award a top 3 performance, there will be a fixed difference of 8 percent of the maximum points dividing the positions 1-4.

The rest of the positions will have a decay factor of 0,92.

* Example:

A player participating in the Danish Open in the women's category with 16 participants and finishing 7th will get:

• 59,18 % of 75 points = 44,39 points

A player participating in a Matchplay Championship in the men's +55 category with 9 participants and finishing 4th will get:

• 76,00 % of 75 points = 57,00 points
